Youth Leaders Rules/Regulations Holbrook Campground

To ensure the safety of all youth, these rules are set aside for leaders in compliance with the Holbrook Campground Youth Committee:

- Leaders must remain on grounds from the beginning of Youth Building opening to closing, 3pm Sunday July 14th 10:00am Saturday July 20th, after lodgers have been picked up and walk through of Youth Building has been completed.
- If an emergency arises where the leader must leave the grounds, the leader is required to call a committee member for that day and have her substitute for the duration of time the leader is away from the campground.
- If an emergency arises of any sort, the leader must call a committee member for further involvement and aid.
- No one above the age of 18 is allowed to stay in the building, unless approved by the committee beforehand.
- Eno's are not allowed inside the Youth Building: no exceptions.
- All forms of tobacco products are prohibited inside and around the Youth Building and/or youth activities. This includes, but is not limited to, vapes, juuls, dip, cigs, etc. If anyone is found with any tobacco item, a leader will contact a member of the committee who is responsible for reporting the incident to the trustees. The leader and/or the committee member will escort the youth in violation of this rule back to their respective tent and speak with a parent/guardian about the issue. If the violator is a lodger, the committee member will make contact with a parent/guardian and lodging may be terminated.
- Each leader will be given a key to a safe, the front doors, and to either the upstairs boys or girls room. This key is to remain with leader only- youth should never be in possession of the keys. If key is lost you will be required to contact one of the committee members ASAP.
- There is now a lockbox on the A/C control downstairs. It will be set on a specific temp 72 degrees. If it needs to be adjusted, contact a committee member.
